



Cookie Policy

What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a small file containing a string of characters that is sent to your computer or mobile device when you first visit a website. The law states that we can store cookies on your device if they are strictly necessary for the operation of this site; for all other types of cookies, we need your permission. This site uses different types of cookies; some cookies are placed by third party services that appear on our pages.

What types of Cookies do we use?

We use two types of Cookies on the Platform: “session cookies” and “persistent cookies.” Session Cookies are temporary Cookies that remain on your device until you leave the website. A persistent Cookie remains on your device for much longer until you manually delete it (how long the Cookie remains will depend on the duration or “lifetime” of the specific Cookie and your browser settings).

What are Cookies used for?

We use cookies to analyse and improve the navigation and content of the website, to personalise content and ads, and to provide social media features. We also share information about your use of our site with our social media, advertising and analytics partners who may combine it with other information that you’ve provided to them or that they’ve collected from your use of their services. As a rule, we do not link IP addresses to anything that can identify you personally, ensuring you can remain anonymous. Nevertheless, we will attempt to use IP addresses to identify a user when we feel it is necessary to protect our services and other users. If there is a security breach, for example, we could use an IP address to trace the breach.

Cookie Declaration

Necessary cookies: help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Preference cookies: enable a website to store information that changes the way the website



behaves or looks, like your login details, preferred language or the region that you are in.

Statistic cookies: help website owners to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously.

Marketing cookies: are used to track visitors across websites. These cookies are used to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third-party advertisers.

Managing Cookies

We use Cookiebot to allow users to manage cookie preferences when they first visit our website.

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see aboutcookies.org. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.

In the links below, you can find information on how to reset and manage cookies in different browsers. The exact procedure depends on which browser you are using. This may interfere with some of the functionality of the site.
